- Getting to know the youth policy of the European Union

goal: creating a long-term cooperation and meeting plan between the young people of the three settlements.

- From the Bottom Up - to explain especially to the young people that the ideas do not come from above, but must start from the bottom, that is, the young people decide what they want!
- Youth conference - how it works, how to join
- Cultural programs that match the spirit of youth.
- Environment, where we live - what young people can do for environmental awareness and the promotion of renewable energy sources.
- Exhibition - about the environmental protection activities of kindergarteners and schoolchildren
- Children for children - musical children's show
- Cooking competition - preparation of traditional dishes of settlements
- "The note is for a good lunch" (programmed lunch) - announcement of the results of the cooking competition
- "Have a say!" - gender inequality today and in everyday life. The partners outline the gender inequality in their country - exchange of experiences
- "How to be equal" - putting forward a proposal from among the participants
- Cultural and children's programs - so that young and old participants of different nationalities get to know each other
- Musical street party

- Workshops - gender inequality, preservation of minorities, the vision of the EU
- Traditional handicrafts, carriage rides, firefighting demonstration, farmers' fair
